Stage 1

Deadline 18/10/2019

Register now and get your team working on their proposal

- Choose and research a topic on saving energy and climate action from one of the categories on our website.
- Teams are made up of 2-6 students
- Primary schools: 3rd- 6th class only
- Post Primary schools:
Junior classes (1st-3rd years) or Senior Classes (4th-6th years)
- Complete the application online at www.seai.ie/onegoodidea
- Proposals will be judged and shortlisted teams will move to Stage 2.
- Shortlisted teams will move on to Stage 2. Schools will be notified by 18th November.



Stage 2

Deadline 31/01/2020

Create a 1 minute film and promote your awareness campaign

- Teams will need to submit their 1-minute film with a PowerPoint presentation online.
- Four regional events will take place between 24th- 28th February (at various locations around the country)



Stage 3

National Final April 2020

- Winners from each regional event will compete at the National Final in Dublin.
